Tranquil residential streets not suitable for bypass routes

Compensatory treatment alternatives will be investigated to minimize right-of-way requirements in highly residential areas.

Current county land development regulations restrict rear access through residential areas. Special overlay district or PDD guidelines may be required to achieve alternate rear parcel access.
